November 2, 2021 Consolidation Election

The Board of Directors (the "Board") for Port O'Connor Improvement District (the "District") has called for a Consolidation Election. The Board has determined it is in the best interest of the District to pursue consolidation with LaSalle WCID 1A. The consolidation will provide POCID additional groundwater pumping capacity with the Calhoun County Groundwater Conservation District. In addition, consolidation with LaSalle should increase the taxable value of the District and potentially provide greater economies of scale and more streamlined operations. La consolidación proporcionará a POCID capacidad adicional de bombeo de agua subterránea con el Distrito de Conservación de Agua Subterránea del Condado de Calhoun. Además, la consolidación con LaSalle debería aumentar el valor gravable del Distrito y lo que podría proporcionar mayores economías de escala y operaciones más simplificadas. Customers who have recently had a **BACKFLOW INSPECTION**, the District needs a copy of your inspection to be in compliance with TCEQ. This helps us to plan for future inspections.

All sprinklers should have a one-time **BACKFLOW INSPECTION** completed & on file with the District. All RV Parks and RPZ Backflows require an annual inspection.

Irrigation Permits

All sprinkler systems require a permit completed and turned in to POCID Office **before** installation. After installation a backflow inspection is required.



The meter AMI installation project is complete. There are some meters that will have to be installed by the district employees due to certain issues. Any meters bigger than 2" will have to be read manually. If you are having any issues, please let us know and we will take care of it as soon as we can. The customer service valves have been completed also. In order to be in compliance with the District Rules & Regulations you need to have a customer service valve within 3 feet of your meter.
