## Why 911 Addresses are Important

What is a 911 address? It is the address of a physical structure that is primarily used to help emergency service personnel find the location. The District also uses these numbers to identify residences and locations for service calls, meter reading, system alerts and to respond to customer calls. Thus, it is very important that these numbers are displayed. Unfortunately, in Port O'Connor where all mail is distributed at the post office and where many residences are secondary homes, these numbers are not present on a lot of homes.

The lack of numbers could cost vital minutes in an emergency situation with emergency responders unable to locate the residence in question. This will become more and more of an issue as Port O'Connor continues to grow. From the District's perspective, the absence of identifying numbers leads to a very inefficient use of District resources—including time and funds. Therefore, the District urges all customers to please have their 911 addresses posted on the premises.

Emergency provider organizations offer the following guidelines for the increased visibility of 911 addresses:

1. The preference is for white numbers against dark backgrounds. The guidelines discourage the use of black numbers because they are very difficult to see at night (as are similarly colored numbers and backgrounds).
2. The numbers should be located near the front door and within the area illuminated by the front porch light for night-time visibility.
3. The numbers should be at least four inches in height.
4. The numbers should be readily seen from the road.
5. Care should be taken to keep shrubbery and other items from blocking the numbers from the view of emergency personnel.

If you do not know your 911 address, you can obtain it by calling Rachel at Calhoun County Emergency Management; her number is 361-552-5455. Please do not call the District office to obtain your number because only the owner of the property in question is allowed to attain that information from Emergency Management. Your posting of the 911 address on your premises will greatly aid the District in serving you and the District's other customers
