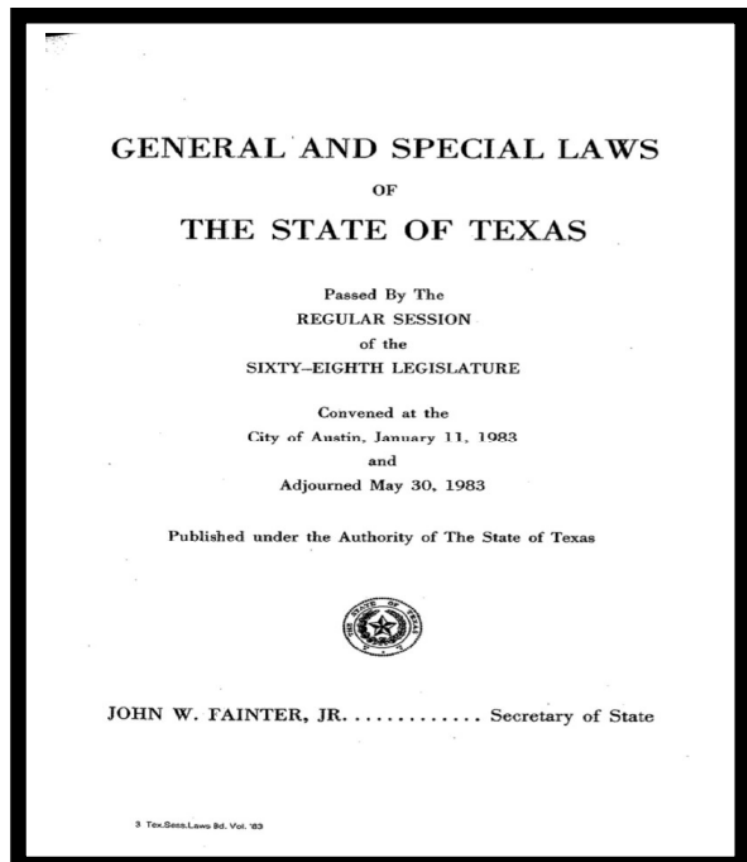

## Looking Back

June 18<sup>th</sup> marks the fortieth anniversary of H.B. No. 2335, the text of which is depicted below. This legislation essentially kick-started the Port O'Connor Municipal Utility District. Although formed in 1977, the District was basically dormant until the passage of H. B. No. 2335 which served to appoint the following temporary directors: John Taylor, Bill Loden, Joe Bright, Kenneth Clark, and Allen Berger. These gentlemen were replaced within a year with Teddy Hawes, Edward Lambright, Calvin Ragusin, John Childers, and Doyle Adams. Hawes, Lambright, Ragusin, Childers, and Adams were the Directors serving at the time of the District's confirmation election which was held on April 7, 1984. A lot has changed and been accomplished since 1983!

#### PORT O'CONNOR MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT--DIRECTORS

##### CHAPTER 1045

H. B. No. 2335

##### AN ACT

relating to the directors of the Port O'Connor Municipal Utility District.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 7, Chapter 693, Acts of the 65th Legislature, Regular Session, 1977, is amended<sup>69</sup> to read as follows:

Sec. 7. (a) ~~The [immediately--after--this--Act--becomes effective;--the]~~ following named persons shall be the temporary directors of the district and shall constitute the temporary board of directors of the district:

1. John Taylor
2. Bill Loden
3. Joe Bright
4. Kenneth Clark
5. Allen Berger

(b) These persons shall qualify to serve as directors prior to the first meeting of the board of directors. Should any of these named directors fail to qualify for any reason, the remaining named directors shall appoint someone to fill the vacancy; provided, however, that if at any time the number of qualified directors shall be less than three because of the failure or refusal of one or more directors to qualify or serve or because of his or their death or incapacitation, or for any other reason, the Texas Water [Rights] Commission shall appoint the necessary number of directors to fill all vacancies on the board. The directors named in Subsection (a) of this section, or their duly appointed and qualified successors, shall serve until the election of

permanent directors, who shall be elected in the manner provided by Sections 54.026-54.029, Water Code. The first elected directors shall draw lots to determine which two directors will serve until the first directors election following the confirmation election ~~on the first Saturday in April, 1978~~, and which three directors will serve until the second directors election following the confirmation election ~~on the first Saturday in April, 1979~~. Subsequent elections of directors shall be held each year as provided in Section 54.103, Water Code, to elect the appropriate number of directors, and directors elected at those elections shall serve for two-year terms.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the emergency condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on May 13, 1983: Yeas 145, Nays 0, 1 present, not voting;  
passed by the Senate on May 23, 1983: Yeas 31, Nays 0.
